4. 2027 Federal Transportation Improvement Program and Financial Plan

Overview

The Orange County Transportation Authority is responsible for the biennial preparation of the Federal Transportation Improvement Program for Orange County. This document is required under state and federal laws and includes the financial information for regionally significant transportation improvement projects in Orange County. A summary of the 2027 Federal Transportation Improvement Program, with a total value of approximately \$2.098 billion, related actions, and a supporting resolution are submitted for the Orange County Transportation Authority Board of Directors' approval.

5. Measure M2 Annual Eligibility Review

The Measure M2 Ordinance No. 3 requires that all local jurisdictions annually satisfy specific eligibility requirements to receive Measure M2 net revenues.
