What is OC RoadMAP?

- If approved by the Board of Supervisors - A competitive, cost sharing partnership program to implement RMRA-eligible transportation projects with the cities of Orange County
- Program will comply with all State RMRA program and reporting guidelines
- Administered by OC Public Works



OC RoadMAP Goals



Enhance safety and condition of transportation infrastructure in Orange County



Allocate funding strategically to raise the overall roadway conditions throughout the county



Improve quality of life by expanding the “complete streets” approach within transportation projects



Optimize the use of critical roadway funding throughout the county



OC RoadMAP Framework

- A call for projects will be issued annually
- Available funding will be determined annually after considering current and future County road maintenance and capital project needs
 - Initially \$5 million per year
- Funding distributed on a reimbursement basis for eligible expenses

OC RoadMAP Administration

- Program documents are under development
- An advisory committee consisting of the County Engineer and five City Engineers representing each District will review, score, and rank project applications
 - City representatives will be appointed by CEAOC
- Participating cities will enter into a cooperative agreement with the County to receive funds

OC RoadMAP Program Development – Next Steps

- Form a working group to provide input on program materials
 - Proposed schedule and working session topics
 - May 2026: bylaws
 - June 2026: bylaws/guidelines
 - July 2026: bylaws/guidelines
 - August 2026: guidelines/template agreement
 - **Interested parties should submit letters of interest by April 30th to the Program Manager**
