2. Fiscal Year 2017-18 Budget Amendment

Overview

The Southern California Regional Rail Authority recently informed the Orange County Transportation Authority that \$6,000,000 in Federal Transit Administration funds is unavailable to offset the Fiscal Year 2017-18 member agency contribution due to the timing of the grant application processes.

Recommendation

Amend the Orange County Transportation Authority Fiscal Year 2017-18 budget by \$6,000,000, to enable Orange County Transportation Authority to pay its fiscal year 2017-18 member agency contribution to Southern California Regional Rail Authority.

Amendment to Purchase Order for Cloud-Based Recruitment Software Karen DeCrescenzo/Maggie McJilton

Overview

On June 12, 2017, the Board of Directors approved sole source procurements for software and hardware licensing, maintenance, and emergency support. A 12-month purchase order was issued to iCIMS, Inc., to provide cloud-based recruitment software for the Human Resources Department. Board of Directors' approval is requested to amend the current purchase order to extend the contract term and increase the maximum cumulative payment obligation.

Recommendation

Authorize the Chief Executive Officer to negotiate and execute Amendment No. 1 to Purchase Order A36775 between the Orange County Transportation Authority and iCIMS, Inc., in the amount of \$77,107, for continued use of cloud-based recruitment software, for an additional two years through October 31, 2019. This will increase the maximum cumulative payment obligation to a total of \$115,661.

4. Draft 2017 Orange County Congestion Management Program Report Release for Public Review Sam Sharvini/Kia Mortazavi

Overview

The Orange County Transportation Authority is responsible for monitoring and reporting on the Orange County Congestion Management Program every two years. In accordance with state law, a draft 2017 Orange County Congestion Management Program Report has been prepared for public review and will be circulated to local agencies upon direction by the Board of Directors.

Recommendation

Direct staff to release the draft 2017 Orange County Congestion Management Program Report for public review, and set November 27, 2017, as a public hearing date for adoption of the final 2017 Orange County Congestion Management Program.

 Contract Change Order for Removal and Disposal of Contaminated Materials for the Metrolink Parking Structure at the Orange Transportation Center Project

Overview

On June 12, 2017, the Orange County Transportation Authority Board of Directors approved Agreement No. C-7-1737 with Bomel Construction Company, Inc., for construction of the Metrolink parking structure at the Orange Transportation Center. A contract change order is required for the removal and disposal of contaminated materials encountered during excavation for construction.

Recommendations

- A. Authorize the Chief Executive Officer to negotiate and execute Contract Change Order No.1.1 to Agreement No. C-7-1737 with Bornel Construction Company, Inc., in an amount of \$863,000, and to add 40 calendar days to the contract duration for the removal and disposal of contaminated materials at the Metrolink parking structure at the Orange Transportation Center.
- B. Amend the Orange County Transportation Authority's Fiscal Year 2017-18 Budget by \$1,930,000, to accommodate Agreement No. C-7-1737, for remediation of contaminated material and other unforeseen expenditures at the Metrolink parking structure at Orange Transportation Center to appropriately account for the required project contingency.

6. 2018 Long-Range Transportation Plan - Proposed Scenarios Greg Nord/Kia Mortazavi

Overview

The Long-Range Transportation Plan provides Orange County's program of projects for the multi-county Regional Transportation Plan, prepared by the Southern California Association of Governments. The plan also serves as a policy framework for future transportation investments in Orange County. Several potential future scenarios will be evaluated to shape the 2018 Long-Range Transportation Plan. The scenarios were defined in a matter that corresponds with the previously reported key trends, issues, and goals. The proposed 2018 Long-Range Transportation Plan scenario principles are presented for review.

Recommendation

Direct staff to return by February 2018 with modeling analysis for the proposed scenarios.

7. SB 1 (Chapter 5, Statutes of 2017) Competitive Programs Adriann Cardoso/Kia Mortazavi

Overview

SB 1 (Chapter 5, Statutes of 2017), the Road Repair and Accountability Act of 2017, will provide an estimated \$52.5 billion for transportation purposes over the next ten years, with investments targeted towards fix-it-first purposes on local streets and roads, highways, transit operations and maintenance, capital investments, and active transportation. An update on the status and general requirements of key competitive programs are presented for review.

Recommendation

Receive and file as an information item.
