4. Amendment to Agreement for Bus Advertising Revenue Program

Overview

On June 22, 2015, the Orange County Transportation Authority Board of Directors approved an agreement with Outfront Media Group, LLC, to sell, place, and maintain advertisements on its fleet of fixed-route and ACCESS vehicles. An amendment to the existing contract is necessary to exercise the first option term of the agreement.

Recommendation

Authorize the Chief Executive Officer to negotiate and execute Amendment No. 1 to Agreement No. C-5-3076 between the Orange County Transportation Authority and Outfront Media, LLC, to exercise the first option term of the agreement, with a minimum guarantee of revenue to the Orange County Transportation Authority in the amount of \$8,000,000, or 70 percent of gross advertising sales revenue, whichever is greater.

5. State Legislative Status Report

Overview

An update is provided on a bill related to the planning and operations of the network of toll roads in Orange County. An oppose position is recommended on a bill related to pension liabilities for joint powers authorities. Overviews are provided of two bills being supported pursuant to the 2017-2018 Orange County Transportation Authority State Legislative Platform. The first bill pertains to three-position bicycle racks on articulated buses, and the second one relates to the cost of electricity as a fuel for transit agencies preparing for zero-emission bus technology.

Recommendation

Adopt an OPPOSE position on AB 1912 (Rodriguez, D-Pomona), which would make member agencies of a joint powers authority jointly and severally liable for the retirement benefits provided by the joint powers authority.

6. Federal Legislative Status Report
