# Overview

The Orange County Transportation Authority invests a portion of its liquid portfolio in the State of California Local Agency Investment Fund. Each month, the State Treasurer's office publishes a report detailing the composition of the pool. The attached summary statements from the report are for the month ending October 31, 2018. The report has been reviewed and is consistent with the investment practices of the State Treasurer's Office.

# Discussion

As of October 31, 2018, the fair value including accrued interest of the Pooled Money Investment Account (PMIA) was \$84,900,466,984 with an average monthly effective yield of 2.14 percent and a month-end weighted average maturity of 201 days. The Local Agency Investment Fund (LAIF) is a component of the State of California PMIA. The month-end balance of LAIF was \$20,205,139,312. The Orange County Transportation Authority's month-end balance in LAIF was \$10,480,795.

The average monthly effective yield is the average of the daily yield for the month. The yield is the income return on an investment, such as the interest received from holding a particular security. The yield is usually expressed as an annual percentage rate based on the investment's cost and current market value.
