#### 1. Approval of Minutes

### 2. Amendment to Agreement for Additional Design Services for the Interstate 5 Improvement Project Between Yale Avenue and State Route 55

A motion was made by Director Foley, seconded by Director Dumitru, and declared passed by those present to authorize the Chief Executive Officer to negotiate and execute Amendment No. 2 to Agreement No. C-0-2371 between the Orange County Transportation Authority and TranSystems Corporation, in the amount of \$1,194,527, for additional design services for the Interstate 5 Improvement Project between Yale Avenue and State Route 55. This will increase the maximum cumulative obligation of the agreement to a total contract value of \$14,653,412.
